## Licensed Practical Nursing (LPN) Program Admission Requirements Information

### Information for Student Applicants

The Nursing Admissions Committee uses a points based system for admission. Minimum admission standards for the Licensed Practical Nursing Program include:

1. Unconditional admission to CVCC
2. Receipt of completed application for the Licensed Practical Nursing program by the deadline
3. A minimum of 2.50 GPA for the last 24 hours of college credit for students with previous college work
4. A minimum of 2.50 cumulative high school GPA for students without prior college work (GED acceptable in lieu of high school transcript)
5. Eligibility for:
  - a. English 101 and Math 100 as determined by college policy
6. Good standing with CVCC
7. Meeting the essential functions or technical standards required for nursing
8. Completion of the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) prior to application
9. Official transcripts from **EACH** college you attended must be submitted to the Admissions Office **BEFORE** the application deadline. Your application will be **INCOMPLETE** if all transcripts are not received and your application will not be considered for admission into the program.
10. Unofficial transcripts from **EACH** college you attended must be submitted along with your nursing application. Your application will be **INCOMPLETE** if all transcripts are not received and your application will not be considered for admission into the program.

***Admission to the Licensed Practical Nursing Program is competitive, and the number of students is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available.  
Meeting minimal requirements does not guarantee acceptance.***

### Health Enrollment Requirements

The following **only** applies to students who have been conditionally accepted into the program.

Students that are conditionally accepted for enrollment into the nursing program will be required to submit the following items after they have been accepted. Students that do not submit or misrepresent the following information will be excluded from the program.

1. Current history and physical completed by a licensed physician (Physical form provided by CVCC)
2. Documentation of immunization - including MMR, Chicken Pox, PPD – TB skin test (If TB tests positive, must have X-ray)
3. Proof of Tetanus shot within last 10 years
4. Hepatitis - B vaccinations or waiver (Hepatitis Waiver form provided by CVCC)
5. Current copy of Health Insurance card
6. Copy of current CPR certification (must be by American Heart Association)
7. Negative Drug Test (Drug Test form provided by CVCC)
8. Background check accepted by clinical facilities
9. Ability to meet Essential Functions with or without reasonable accommodations.

## CALCULATION OF POINTS

After meeting all minimum requirements, applicants are rank-ordered using a point system based on:

- Your score from the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS-V)
- Points for selected college courses (i.e. ENG 101, MTH 100) **OR** selected high school courses (i.e. Algebra II or higher level math, highest level Biology).
- Students may be awarded up to 10 points as determined by individual college policy and procedures.

1. **ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS-V):** This test must have been taken within 3 years for consideration. Points awarded will be based on percentage score equivalent. If you have taken the TEAS-V at another location, an official copy of this test must be sent electronically to CVCC, please visit [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com) for more information. Applicants who fail to submit their official score will not be ranked for admission.

2. **Points Awarded for Selected College Courses:**

**NOTE:** Either college coursework **OR** high school coursework will be evaluated, NOT BOTH. High school coursework will ONLY be used if no college coursework has been attempted. A maximum of two grades can be used for points.

**Please use the following scale: A = 30 points; B = 20 points; C = 10 points**

3. **Additional Points:** Ten (10) loyalty points will be awarded to students who have completed ALL their previous coursework at CVCC. Five (5) loyalty points will be awarded to students who have completed their points based classes (ENG 101, MTH 100 or higher) at CVCC.
