

Dual Enrollment Scholarship Fall Semester 2022

Summary

Chattahoochee Valley Community College has scholarships available through the **CVCC Foundation Scholarship Fund** to support high school students wishing to enroll in a career/technical field such as Welding, Industrial Maintenance, or Emergency Medical Technician.

Scholarships are available for dual enrolled high school students:

- Dual Enrollment Scholarships
 - o **\$500**
 - Tuition, books, equipment, and uniforms
- Scholarship Requirements
 - Complete a Career Interest Exam
 - \circ Completed the 10th grade with at least a 2.5 GPA
 - Signed Statement of Eligibility and Registration Form
 - CVCC Application for Admission form
 - o Student must be enrolled in one of the following; Welding, Industrial Maintenance or EMT

A CVCC Foundation Scholarship recipient will agree to participate in the following:

- CVCC Foundation video shoot
 CVCC Foundation Videos are short clips of scholarship students' testimonials. Videos will be posted on CVCC's Website and shown at events to promote the mission of the CVCC Foundation.

Attend and possibly speak briefly at Alumni and Foundation events

Any scholarship Recipient failing a class will not be considered for future Foundation Scholarships. The Career Coach will provide a list of students eligible to receive the scholarship. At the end of the semester, the Career Coach will provide a grade report for students that receive a scholarship.
